Avoiding/De-escalating Confrontations

“The victim of assault is often **untrained** and **unprepared** to evaluate escalating behavior. They should know and practice methods of defusing hostility or protecting themselves from violence.” The statement from **OSHA** is very clear. We need to recognize potentially dangerous situations, act upon our observations and appropriately report/document our actions. This presentation includes non-confrontational stances, proven methods of de-escalation, bomb threats/response, incident reporting protocols, high risk employment termination retaliation dangers and workplace violence reduction considerations.

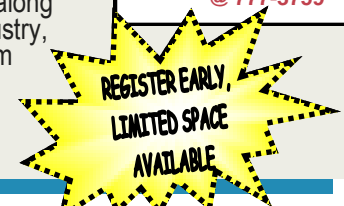
