GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING

Here are some items (in no particular order) that we'll be keeping our eyes on regarding OSHA in 2014:

- revision would update the list of industries that are exempt from reporting injuries and illnesses to OSHA. It would also revise certain reporting requirements. The existing regulations require employers to report to OSHA within eight hours any work-related incident resulting in the death of an employee or the inpatient hospitalization of three or more employees. The revision would require employers to report to OSHA within eight hours all work-related fatalities and all work-related inpatient hospitalizations; and within 24 hours, all work-related amputations.
- requirement. OSHA chief David Michaels has referred to this initiative as his No. 1 priority. In its most recent regulatory agenda, OSHA estimates it will release a notice of proposed rulemaking on I2P2 in September 2014. While the Obama administration has three years left, the clock is ticking on this one. It's likely the agency doesn't meet the September date for releasing the NPRM, but if it's not released by the end of 2014, this administration will only have two years to enact I2P2.
- Process safety management changes. As called for by President Obama's executive order on improving chemical safety, OSHA intends to issue a request for information (RFI) regarding process safety management and prevention of major chemical incidents. The RFI will identify issues related to updating OSHA's Process Safety Management standard.
